

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

The Placitas Trails Water Co-op has a level of Arsenic above Drinking Water Standards in the fourth quarter of 2009

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We routinely monitor for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Testing results from quarterly arsenic samples collected on February 25, 2009, June 19, 2009, September 14, 2009 and December 18, 2009 show that Well 3&4 exceeded the standard, or maximum contaminant level (MCL), for arsenic. The current running annual average for arsenic is 0.037 mg/L (37 ppb). The standard for arsenic is 0.010 mg/L. Therefore, Placitas Trails Water Co-op has exceeded the arsenic maximum contaminant level (MCL) in the fourth quarter of 2009 (Oct. – Dec.).

What should I do?

You do not need to use an alternative (e.g., bottled) water supply. However, if you have specific health concerns, or have a compromised immune system you may consult your doctor or drink and use bottled water.

What does this mean?

This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However some people who drink water containing arsenic in excess of the MCL over many years could experience skin damage or problems with their circulatory system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What happened? What is being done?

The arsenic in our water is from erosion of natural deposits. The Placitas Trails Water Co-op will continue to post this arsenic public notice every 3 months as long as this MCL exceedence persists. We are also exploring options that will reduce the arsenic level in our water to a level that is under the MCL.


